CoreSource Customer Service Feedback

Last summer, the District Benefits Office surveyed CoreSource members to elicit feedback about their services. We received 251 responses, about 1/4th of the employee/retiree population. Full results can be found on the Peralta.edu website. Thank you for our feedback. PCCD has enhanced service in the following ways. We have:

- distributed the Summary Plan description to each family unit,
- established a dedicated customer service line for Peralta employees and retirees
- added claims resolution assistance provided by our benefits broker, PSW Benefit Resources.

Tips to effectively utilize your CoreSource Plan:

1. Present your card at the point of service-the card has useful reference information.
2. Confirm with your in-network providers that they know the billing procedure.
3. Ensure that claims are submitted completely and accurately (standard information includes name of patient, diagnosis codes and some narrative description of services performed).

Following are a few options to consider:

◆ 24 Hour Fitness Health Clubs

Peralta Community College District has partnered with the nation's leader in fitness, **24 Hour Fitness**, to offer their colleagues zero enrollment, reduced processing and discounted dues on a **24 Hour Fitness** membership.

Pay first and last month's dues and you're in. These are "pay as you go" memberships (no long-term contract). Dues may either be paid monthly through electronic funds transfer, or annually.

Bring your business card, current pay stub, or badge as proof of employment (required at time of enrollment).

Our Bronze membership features:

- Processing fee \$49
- Monthly fees as little as \$29.99
- Family members can join at reduced monthly rates.

◆ Trustees formally approve reimbursement programs

On February 6, 2007, the Peralta Board of Trustees formally approved the eligibility criteria for the District-sponsored medical expense programs. Now,

- *Management and Confidential employees can receive Kaiser mail order prescription reimbursement*
- *All retirees are eligible for the Medicare Reimbursement Programs.*

A personal communication will be mailed to affected employees and retirees in late March.

◆ Weight Watchers

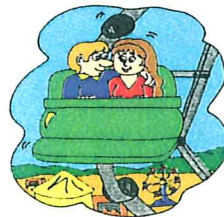


Kaiser members receive a discount!
